



Why St. Thomas and the US Virgin Islands?

St. Thomas has all the tropical flair of an international Caribbean destination, yet all the benefits of being a US territory. The currency is the US dollar, and island infrastructure follows US health and safety standards. The United States Virgin Islands are known as America's first paradise. St. Thomas, the largest island, is located in one of the most picturesque geographical areas in the world.

Weather

St. Thomas is blessed with 85 degree temperature and sun-drenched weather year round, cooled by the soft blowing trade winds.

Three ...or Four! Destinations in One

Enjoy all that St. Thomas offers *and* St. John USVI and the British Virgin Islands! Red Hook, a 3 minute drive from the resort, has hourly ferries to St. John. Ferries are also available to the British Virgin Islands from Red Hook and from downtown Charlotte Amalie. Guests can also visit St. Croix, the largest of the three primary US Virgin Islands - a 20 minute sea plane ride or by ferry (approximately 1.5 hours).

Accessibility

St. Thomas is one of the most accessible islands in the Caribbean. Air service to St. Thomas is among the best to any Caribbean destination. Our main airport is Cyril E. King International Airport, which receives daily non-stop flights from 5 major airlines from Chicago, Detroit, New York, Newark, Philadelphia, Washington D.C., Charlotte, Atlanta, Fort Lauderdale, Miami and San Juan. Airlift is available on American Airlines, United, Continental, Delta, Spirit, and US Airways.

LOCATION & AREA ATTRACTIONS

Wyndham Sugar Bay Resort & Spa is located at the northeastern end of St. Thomas. The resort is located on 32 hillside acres and overlooks the emerald and blue waters of Water Bay, St. John and the British Virgin Islands, where the Atlantic Ocean and Caribbean Sea meet to create Pillsbury sound.

The Wyndham Sugar Bay Resort & Spa is only 8 miles from Cyril E. King International Airport and the following distances from area attractions, such as:

Charlotte Amalie: Capital of the US Virgin Islands, a charming and gracious town named in 1692 for the Queen of Denmark. World famous for being the Caribbean capital of duty free shopping, Charlotte Amalie's main streets are lined with historic Danish buildings restored to house the Caribbean's best merchants. History and culture aficionados can visit historic Ft. Christian, the birthplace of artist Camille Pissaro, the second oldest synagogue in the western hemisphere and numerous art galleries.
(5 miles from Sugar Bay).

St. Peter Greathouse & Botanical Gardens: A 3 (three) acre estate featuring some of the island's best views and a stunning gardens and grounds, the Greathouse is also available for private functions (6 miles from Sugar Bay).

Red Hook: In addition to serving as the island's primary nightlife center with 14 restaurants and bars, Red Hook is the predominant ferry port for St. John and the neighboring British Virgin Islands (1 mile from Sugar Bay).

Mountain Top: The best north side and down-island view from one of St. Thomas' highest mountain peaks (6 miles from Sugar Bay).

Coral World: A four and a half acre beautifully landscaped marine life park and underwater natural aquarium/ observatory (1 mile from Sugar Bay).

Magen's Bay Beach: Rated as one of the world's top beaches, Magen's Bay offers a picturesque setting and calm shallow bay. Changing facilities, gift store, bar and a restaurant are available at Magen's Bay. (5 miles from Sugar Bay).

Paradise Point Tramway: Ride the tramway 700 ft. straight up Flag Hill to "Paradise Point" for a picturesque panoramic view of the Charlotte Amalie Harbor. Shopping, restaurant and bar are also found at the top - featuring the world famous Bushwacker.
(6 miles from Sugar Bay).

Mahogany Run Golf: Golf by the sea at this 18-hole championship golf designed by Tom & George Fazio, world renowned for its breathtaking beauty and seductive challenge. Home of Devil's Triangle, a trio of holes located along the beautiful north coast of St. Thomas. The Pro Shop at Mahogany Run is open year round 7 days a week. It is fully stocked with golf apparel from brands such as Ashworth, Nicklaus, Izod and Gear as well as a wide assortment of golf hats. Titleist, Top Flight, Precept, Pinnacle and Wilson golf balls; Callaway woods and irons; and Ping putters are also available.
